

## Linda's Little Laboratory Childcare

### What to bring on the first day of care:

1. Payment for your first week of care, your two week deposit, a total of three weeks. Payment for the week is always due on Mondays.
2. Yellow immunization card, will be returned that afternoon after I log it onto a blue immunization form which is a state requirement.
3. Bottles, and formula , baby food is supplied by me according to child's age.
4. Diapers one full bag at a time, I will inform you when more is needed.
5. Diaper wipes refill size, I love Huggies or Pampers they are stronger and thicker for germ control, I will inform you when more is needed. Wipes are shared with all children.
6. Change of clothes, including socks, for infants bring at least two onesie shirts.
7. Bathing suit to be left here (summer), and a zip up sweatshirt to be left here (fall and winter) the string will be removed.
8. Bring a happy face and enjoy the rest of your day
9. If you wish to bring a healthy snack, make sure it is enough for 14 children, and 2 adults.

### What not to bring to Childcare:

1. **ABSOLUTLY!! NO!** Gum, candy, coins, small balls, or other items that can cause choking.
2. No books or movies, unless you have asked ahead of time. I have plenty of things to play with and movies to watch and books to read. When you bring things from home it only helps you and then I have to be the bad guy when I take it away at the first opportunity. Children at this age are not good at sharing their things from home. When the toy or movie goes missing it is a miserable day for all.
3. Try not to come to childcare in a hurried, harried, angry fashion. This just makes the child's day weird, they wonder about Mommy or Daddy. I want the children too have a good and safe time. I want you to be at work with your full focus on your job so that at pick-up time your full focus can fall to the children.
